Scripture References: Proverbs 29:18

A vision is a dream or revelation. God wants to bring your dreams to pass. No matter how old you are or how many mistakes you have made, God still has a plan for you.

Have I let my dreams from God fall by the wayside?

Having vision will bring focus to your life.

1. Psalm 139:16 // All the days of your life were ordained by God.
2. Jeremiah 29:11 // God has a plan with a hope and a future for you.

Is your life so busy that you're not focused on God's plan for you?

Having vision will bring endurance.

1. You won't quit or give up when you have a God-given vision that you're pursuing.

When there is no vision, people:

1. Hurt themselves and others.
2. Bark at everyone around them.
3. Sit and do nothing.
4. Can't endure to the end.

Having vision will bring fulfillment.

Simple steps to finding your purpose:

1. What am I doing that I should not be doing?

 - a. Take steps in the right direction. (James 4:17)
3. Why not do it today?
 - a. 2 Corinthians 6:2
 - b. Ecclesiastes 3:11
