Proverbs 11:25 (The Message) “The one who blesses others is abundantly blessed; those who help others are helped.”

1. God blessed us to be a blessing, but we need to seek God first then all the other things will follow. God will bless those who are generous.
2. If you're faithful over little, you'll be faithful over much.

Jesus became poor so that we might become rich.

1. What you sow, you will reap.
2. 2015 is the year God wants to put His good measure, pressed down, shaken together on you.

Acts 20: 35 (NLT) “It is more blessed to give than it is to receive.”

1. If God can get it through you, He will give it to you.
